"Not" Adverb Examples (adverbs modify verbs and adjectives)

- Jan *isn't* coming. She's *not* feeling very well.
- She might not be joking. It could be true.
- They **don't** go to school on Wednesday afternoons.
- Living in a small flat **does not** make it easy to have pets.
- I hadn't decided whether to take the train or go by car.
- They can't be hungry again. They've only just eaten.
- Zingos contain additives, so my children shouldn't eat any.



"No" Adjective Examples (adjectives modify nouns)

- There were no newspapers left in the shop by one o'clock.
- Help! I've **no** time left to complete this job.
- It's **no** joke bringing up a child on your own.
- It's **no** good. You'll have to start again.

Pronoun Examples

- I've given him toys, sweets and cartoons but nothing keeps him quiet.
- Nobody came to the house for several days.
- None of my cousins live near us.
- I've tried all the hotels, but there's **nowhere** with any space for us.
- I looked out the window but **no one** was there.

Neither-Nor Examples

- How do I get my child to behave? Neither bribes nor threats seem to work.
- Chemicals have poisoned the lake. **Neither** the frogs **nor** the toads survived.
- I asked them both the question but **neither** knew the correct answer.
- "We have either beer or wine". "Neither, thanks."
