## "Not" Adverb Examples <br> (adverbs modify verbs and adjectives)

- Jan isn't coming. She's not feeling very well.
- She might not be joking. It could be true.
- They don't go to school on Wednesday afternoons.
- Living in a small flat does not make it easy to have pets.
- I hadn't decided whether to take the train or go by car.
- They can't be hungry again. They've only just eaten.
- Zingos contain additives, so my children shouldn't eat any.


## Adverb Examples

(adverbs modify verbs and adjectives)

- I am not happy
- I am never happy
- That's not green, that's yellow.

- She's never been abroad.
- I will never speak to him again.
- I will not eat cake until Christmas.



## "No" Adjective Examples (adjectives modify nouns)

- There were no newspapers left in the shop by one o'clock.
- Help! I've no time left to complete this job.
- It's no joke bringing up a child on your own.
- It's no good. You'll have to start again.


## Pronoun Examples

- I've given him toys, sweets and cartoons - but nothing keeps him quiet.
- Nobody came to the house for several days.
- None of my cousins live near us.
- I've tried all the hotels, but there's nowhere with any space for us.
- I looked out the window but no one was there.


## Neither-Nor Examples

- How do I get my child to behave? Neither bribes nor threats seem to work.
- Chemicals have poisoned the lake. Neither the frogs nor the toads survived.
- I asked them both the question but neither knew the correct answer.
- "We have either beer or wine". "Neither, thanks."
