Relative Pronouns

Relative Clauses & Pronouns

Clause gives more information about a noun that comes before it

The **boy** is tall. **He** plays basketball →

The **boy** is tall {**who** plays basketball} →

The **boy** {**who** plays basketball} is tall.

Pronouns who, whom, whose, which, that, where, when, why, what

Some examples

- “They live in a **house**. **Its** roof is full of holes”.
 - “An elephant is an **animal**. **It** lives in hot countries”.
 - “Let's go to a warmer **country**. Let's go to a sunny country”.
- ➡ “They live in a **house** **whose** roof is full of holes”.
 - ➡ “An elephant is an **animal** **that** lives in hot countries”.
 - ➡ “Let's go to a **country** **where** it's sunny”.

Some examples

- “She is an **athlete**. **She** never wins a race”. ➔ “She is an **athlete** **who** never wins a race”.
- “This is the **man**. I met **him** at the cinema”. ➔ “This is the **man** **whom** I met at the cinema”.
- “**We** are tired. Let’s take a rest”. ➔ “Let’s take a rest **when** **we** are tired”
